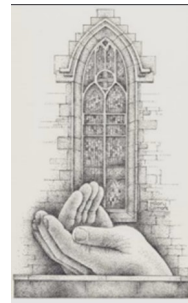
St. Francis de Sales wrote a beautiful prayer for such cases. It is a prayer that seeks to calm our weary hearts, beckoning us to "be at peace."

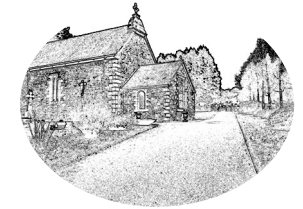

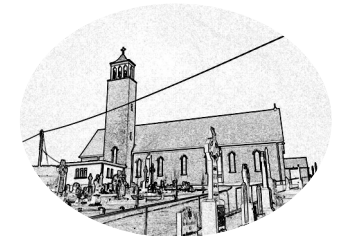
